RGPL is committed to:

- Conduct all its activities in such a manner as to avoid harm to employees, contractors and the community.
- Promote occupational health of its employees and contractors.
- Improve continuously its environmental practices and performance.
- Prevent adverse impact on environment and risks to the communities that arise due to its operations.
- Utilize energy resources in a responsible and efficient manner so as to reduce emissions.
- Comply with all statutory and other requirements concerning Health, Safety, Environment and Quality.
- Create a culture of learning and practice Health, Safety, Environment & Quality systems, procedures & practices among all its employees & contractors, risk based thinking and continual improvements.

RGPL strives to achieve these objectives by:

- Designing plants with proper and adequate safeguards for ensuring process safety.
- Carrying out process related and operational changes through well defined systems and strict adherence to the same.
- Following effective use of safe work procedures and practices for operation, maintenance, inspection and emergency situations.
- Reviewing regularly and updating of systems and procedures.
- Training and validating employees and contractors on health and safety practices.
- Conducting all work in safe manner and to ensure integrity of the assets, by providing personal protective equipment, tools and tackles.
- Investigating all incidents relating to Health, Safety and Environment including minor ones, near misses followed by implementation of corrective measures.
- Periodically reviewing customers' requirements

- Communicating learning from investigations of incidents, internal and external, to all employees and taking steps to prevent such occurrences in its works.
- Auditing periodically internal and external work procedures and practices.
- Identifying and evaluating health risks related to its operations and carrying out preemployment and periodic medical check-up of its employees.
- Implementing programs and appropriate protective measures to control such risks.
- Continuous monitoring of work environment and emissions and taking measures to achieve better environmental performance
- Interacting with local communities on operations, likely hazards and emergency response systems.
- Keeping abreast of latest international codes, standards and practices and adopting the same where applicable.

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
